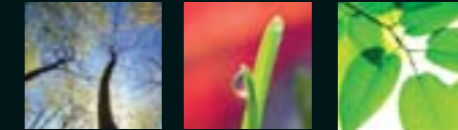


Case Study— Japanese Knotweed

THE BENEFIT

THE PROJECT

Kennedy Wilson (Europe) was looking to acquire some property from CIE however, before negotiations could progress, site investigations needed to take place within a landlocked part of the site that was heavily infested with Japanese Knotweed.

The site was bounded by existing residential properties and on the opposing side was the main rail line out of Dublin Heuston train station, therefore all equipment needed to be craned into and out of site.
